First records of two staphylinid species (Coleoptera, Staphylinidae) from Slovakia

Atheta nidicola (Johansen, 1914)

Material examined: C Slovakia, sites Paľova jamka, Javorinka and Pivnička near Hriňová (48°34' N, 19°24' E), 19.VII.1996, 3 ♀♀; C Slovakia, site Laštek near Detva (48°33' N, 19°31' E), 19.VII.1996 1 ♂, 1 ♀, all in nests of *Lanius minor*, leg. T. Krištín, det. Z. Šustek. A species given to occur in Slovakia, but up to present not confirmed by autochthonous material (BOHÁČ, 1993). First authentic records of the species from Slovakia.

Atheta spelaea (Erichson, 1840)

Material examined: E Slovakia, Ardovská jaskyňa cave (48°31' N, 20°25' E), 4.VIII.1997, 1 ♀, leg. L. Kováč, det. Z. Šustek). According to FREUDE et al. (1973) the

nearest localities are in Lower Austria. First record of the species from Slovakia.
